### To Qualify

In order to qualify for this Tech Prep program, a student must have met the following qualifications by the end of the sophomore year of high school: Completed algebra I (or equivalent) with a "C" or better, completed biology I with a "C" or better, earned a minimum 2.0 G.P.A., and have junior standing with no academic deficiencies. Preferences for entering a Tech Prep program include computer keyboarding skills and good attendance.

### 11th Grade Tech Prep Classes

Allied Health Labs include medical terminology, health care systems, career exploration, office skills, and psychology. College prep academics include math, chemistry, and English III.

### 12th Grade Tech Prep Classes

Allied Health Labs include patient care, infection control, first aid & medical emergencies, and human relations. College prep academics include English IV, anatomy & physiology, social studies, and physics.

### College

Earn an associate degree from Sinclair Community College in one of the following majors: Dental Hygiene, Dietetics & Nutritional Management, Health Information Management, Integrated Medical Massage, Medical Assistant Technology, Mental Health Technologies, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapist Assistant, Radiologic Technology, Respiratory Care, or Surgical Technology.

Students graduating from Sinclair may choose to pursue a bachelor's degree in Allied Health. Sinclair currently has articulation agreements with Andrews University, Capital University, College of Mt. St. Joseph, Miami University, The Ohio State University, Raymond Walters College, University of Cincinnati, and Wright State University.

### Career Prospects
