

Transferring CTAG (Career Transfer Assurance Guide) Credit to Another College or University:

CTAG credit can be transferred to another college or university. However, it is important to consult with an Academic Advisor at the destination school to verify how the credit will transfer and apply toward the student's major of study.

Students planning to transfer to a public institution within Ohio should consult a representative with that college/university about their CTAG retrieval process.

Students transferring to a private institution within Ohio or out-of-state college/university, please follow the steps below:

Step 1: To have CTAG credit transferred to another college or university, students will need to order an [official transcript](#) be sent directly to the receiving institution.

Step 2: CTAG credit is listed as transfer credits on the transcript and appears as a lump sum at the end of the transcript.

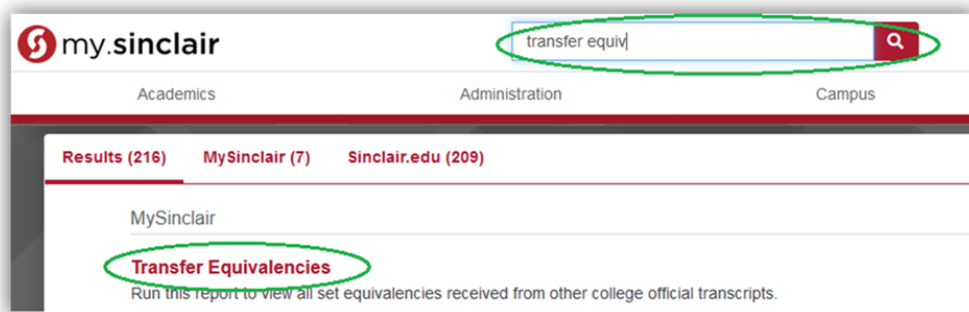

Because of this, receiving institutions will not automatically transfer the credit in. Students can obtain a **Transfer Equivalency Report** through their <https://my.sinclair.edu> portal. The **Transfer Equivalency Report** displays both information about the courses that were accepted from your former institution and information about the Sinclair course to which they equate.

To view your **Transfer Equivalency** Reports:

- Search for Transfer Equivalencies as shown in the screenshot below:



- Save the reports, attach them in an email and send to your college or university
