Option 1: Attendance 30%, Discussion 30%, Mid-term and Final 40% each. Required Course Assessments include: 16 Discussions, Two Tests. 2 Rubrics are used for scoring in the course. High school instructor is responsible for grading. Grades must be posted in eLearn. Assessments are a BANK of questions for the teachers to draw from, however instructors do not have to give or assign all of the questions. Option 2: If a student is a member of FFA and they have successfully completed the requirements of your FFA chapter for the 2020-2021 academic school year, the student would receive course credit for AGR 1160. Simply enter a final grade of “Y”. Class is completed.

What is the grading scale for the course?
For Option 1: 100- 90 = A 89-80 = B 79-70=C 69-60= D 59 Below F. Option 2: Y = credit earned as ‘pass’
