Additional Requirements for Credit:
1) Certification must be current. 2) Certification must be current. Students who hold an AEMT certification are eligible to receive credit if they have not already received college credit for EMT training. 3) Certification must be current. In addition to the credits awarded for the Paramedic ITAG, students are eligible to receive credit for the EMT ITAG if they have not already received college credit for EMT training. Institutional policies regarding minimum academic residency requirements or maximum amounts of articulated or transfer credit still apply and may impact if all credits can be awarded and/or applied toward a program. 4) Certification must be current. NREMT certification is eligible for academic credit; however, to continue to an Ohio paramedic training program, current Ohio EMT certification is required.

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- 5) Certification must be current. NREMT certification is eligible for academic credit if the student has not already received college credit for EMT training; however, to continue to an Ohio paramedic training program, current Ohio EMT certification is required.
- 6) Certification must be current. In addition to the credit awarded for the Paramedic ITAG, students are eligible to receive credit for the EMT ITAG if they have not already received college credit for EMT training.
