

TO QUALIFY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Earn a cumulative high school grade point average (GPA) of a 2.25 Junior year and the first semester of Senior year.
- Complete three or more career technical education courses, or two courses in a single pathway, and graduate from high school.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) annually. Other financial aid must be used prior to using the Sinclair Tech Prep Scholarship.
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester to be eligible for full scholarship benefits of \$750.00 per term. Enrollment for 9 to 11 hours will be pro-rated at \$563.00 per term.
- Maintain good academic standing as defined in the Sinclair Community College catalog “Grades” section (i.e., a GPA of 2.0 or higher).

HOW TO GET STARTED

- 1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at fafsa.ed.gov.** Needs to be completed by May 1 of the year you graduate. **Sinclair Code is 003119.**
- 2. Meet with an Academic Advisor** and develop a class schedule/register for classes: To schedule an appointment, please call **(937) 512-3700** or visit **www.sinclair.edu/advising**. Please note, in order to use your scholarship, you **MUST** declare a major.
- 3. Check your Sinclair email frequently** for funding and scholarship updates.
